While we encourage those who have presented at CDFSC conferences in the past to submit an abstract, priority in the review of abstracts will be given to those who have not presented recently.

Undergraduate students, graduate students, faculty, activists, and others committed to feminist social change are invited to submit an abstract of 250 words for an afternoon poster session.
