*Siena Fast Facts*

Welcome back to a new semester! This week our *Fast Facts* will take a quick look at our day 1 enrollment for the spring 2017 semester. These data are not official, of course (the official numbers will be released after census day in a few weeks), but they should give us a pretty good idea of where we stand.

The table below shows undergraduate enrollment for day 1 of spring 2017, compared to day 1 of spring 2016.

The number of full-time, matriculated undergraduates has increased by 60 from this time a year ago, which is a good sign. There is very little difference in the number of part-time and non-matriculated students.

The table below shows graduate enrollment (i.e. Masters in Accounting) for day 1 of spring 2017, compared to day 1 of spring 2016.

"Hybrid" MACC	29	35

The number of full-time graduate students has increased from this time a year ago, although the number of part-time graduate students has declined. The last row ("Hybrid MACC") shows the number of students who are currently classified as undergraduate accounting majors, but who are taking graduate MACC or GBUS courses. This is an important group to track because most of these students will matriculate into the graduate program after receiving their undergraduate accounting degree.

Finally, the table below shows the number of new students matriculating into Siena in the spring term.

Typically there are very few new students (i.e. first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students) who matriculate in the spring term. However, we do typically welcome a significant number of new transfer students to Siena in the spring term. Please make these students feel welcome as they begin their time at Siena!
