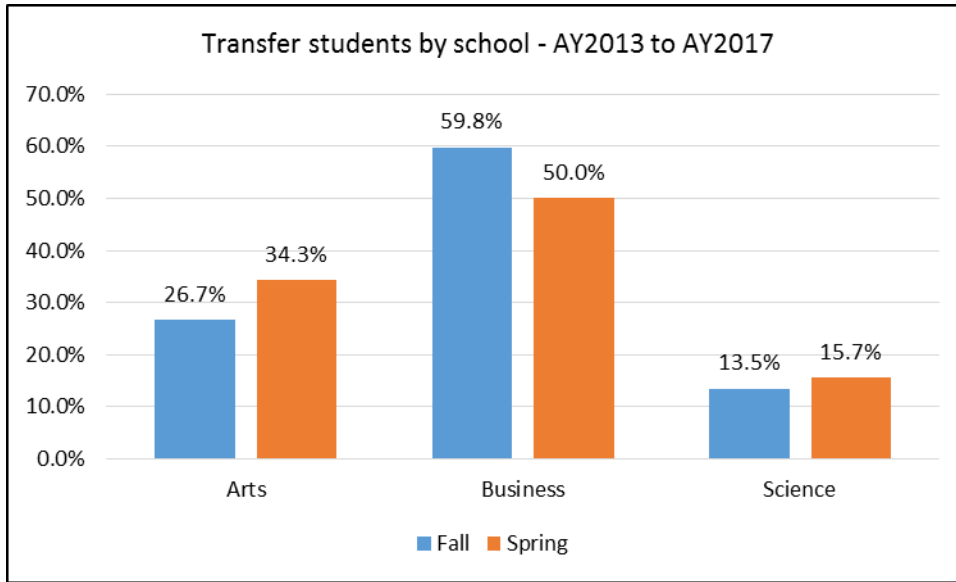

*Siena Fast Facts*

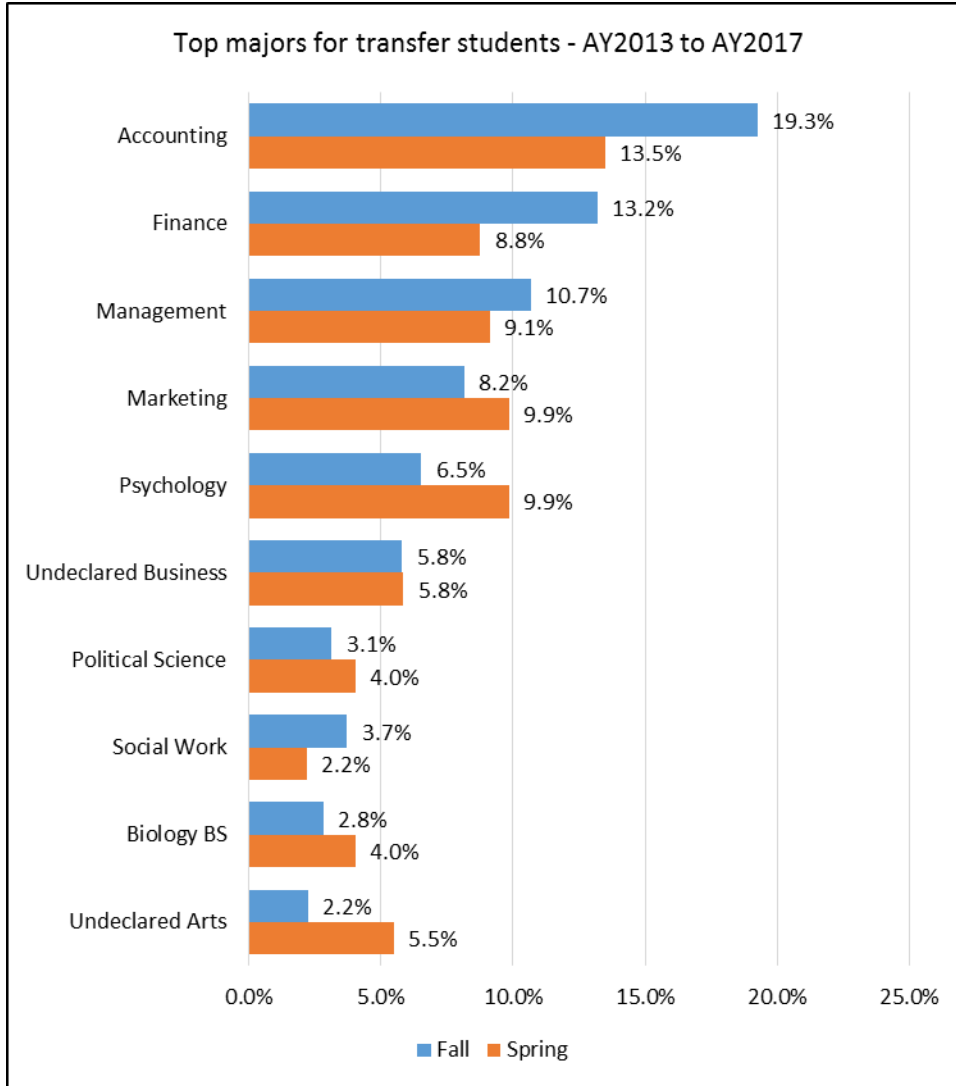
This week we'll continue to look at our spring transfer students, focusing their schools and majors.

The chart below shows the distribution of transfer students by school (at the time of matriculation) for the past few years.



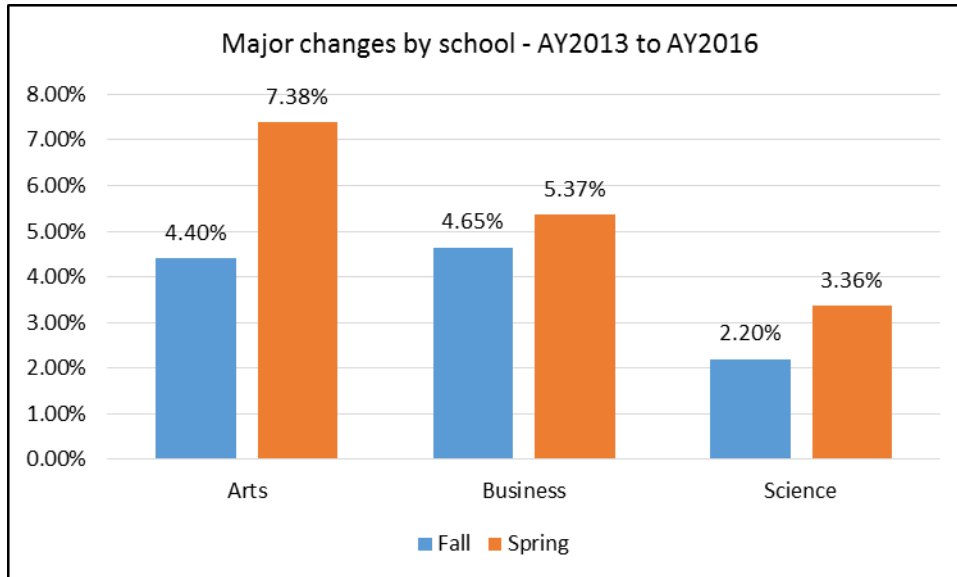
Spring transfers are somewhat more likely to matriculate into the School of Arts, and somewhat less likely to matriculate into the School of Business. This reflects in part the fact that spring transfers are less likely to come from the local community colleges and from CEFAM (all of which tend to feed into our business majors).

The chart below shows the top ten majors for transfer students for the same time period.



Spring transfers are less likely to be Accounting and Finance majors, but are somewhat more likely to be Psychology or Undeclared Arts majors.

Finally, the chart below shows the percentage of transfer students who changed majors in their first year. (These data only include retained students who matriculated with a declared major.)



Only a small percentage of transfer students change majors, but spring transfers are somewhat more likely to change majors than fall transfers.
