Siena Fast Facts

This week in our *Fast Facts* we will conclude our series on the Noel-Levitz Student Satisfaction Inventory (NLSSI).

An interesting item on the NLSSI asks students if the college they attended was their first, second, or third or lower choice. The table below shows overall satisfaction ratings based on students' college choice. The three overall satisfaction questions are:

- So far, how has your college experience met your expectations?
- Rate your overall satisfaction with your experience here thus far.
- All in all, if you had to do it over, would you enroll here again?

About 52% of respondents who answered this question stated that Siena was their first choice, whereas about 16% stated that Siena was their third choice or lower. Not surprisingly, students who stated that Siena was their first choice had much higher satisfaction ratings.
