

This week our *Fast Facts* will continue to take a look at some fall enrollment numbers, focusing specifically on schools and majors. Numbers are based on census day enrollment.

The chart below shows full-time undergraduate enrollment by school.




All three schools have seen an increase in enrollment from last fall, with the School of Science showing the largest increase.

As in the past, Accounting and Psychology remain the top two majors. However, there has been some juggling for position in some of the other top majors.

The chart below shows the majors with the greatest increase in numbers from fall 2015 to fall 2016.



Finally, it should be noted that we have two new majors this fall: the Business major with 9 students (8 full-time and 1 part-time), and the Nursing major, with 10 students (3 full-time and 7 part-time).
