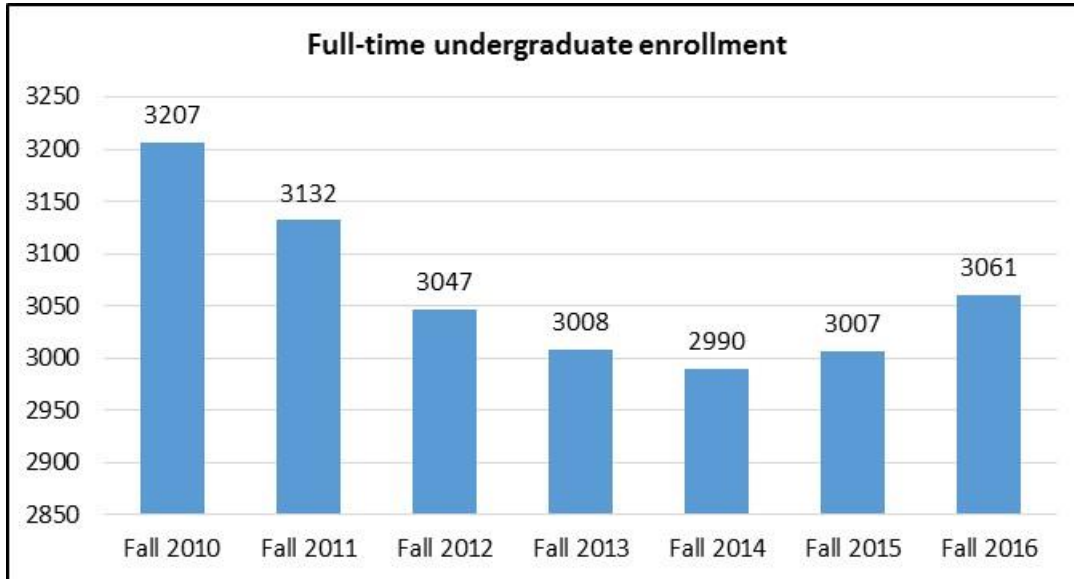

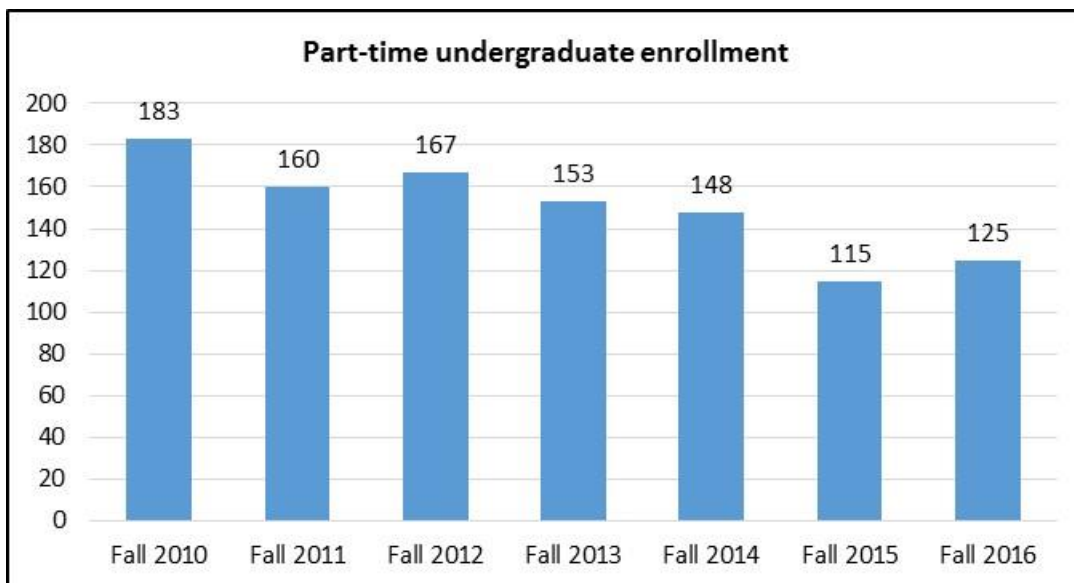
*Siena Fast Facts*

Now that fall census day is past, our *Fast Facts* will take a look at some enrollment numbers. The chart below shows the full-time undergraduate enrollment for the past seven fall terms.



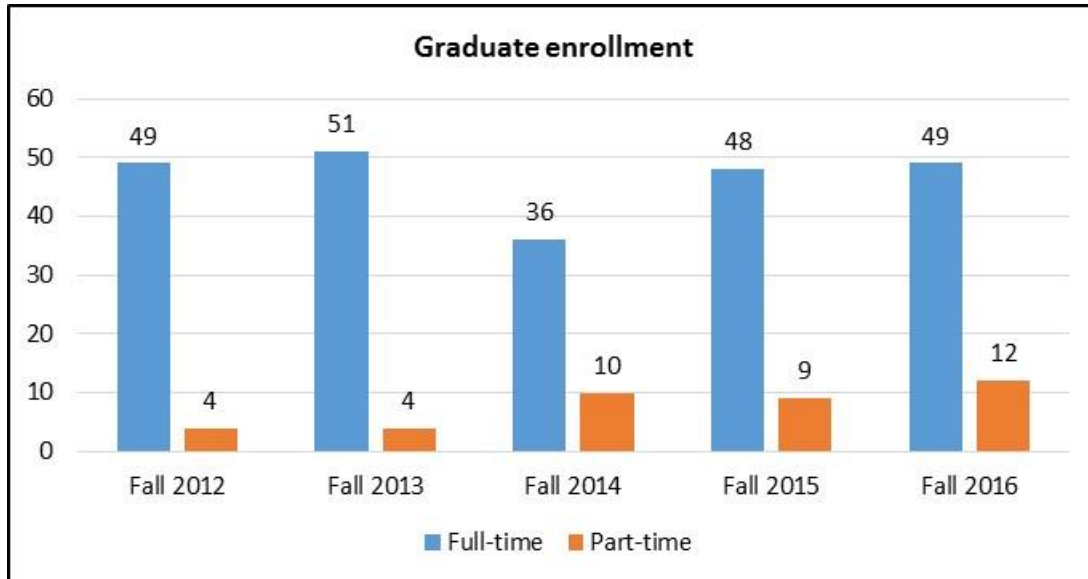
There was a decline in full-time undergraduate enrollment from fall 2010 to fall 2014, but in fall 2015 there was a modest upturn followed by a larger increase in fall 2016.

The chart below shows the part-time undergraduate enrollment for the past seven fall terms.



There has been a fairly steady decline in part-time enrollment since fall 2010, and an especially sharp drop in fall 2015. However, there was a modest increase in fall 2016.

The chart below shows graduate enrollment for the past five fall terms.



For the most part, full-time graduate enrollment has been fairly steady, with the exception of a dip in fall 2014. Part-time enrollment has increased a bit in the past three years.
