Study abroad enables actuarial science students to engage with the field in a new cultural context, meet with local, national and international business leaders, pursue internships across all industries, and so much more!

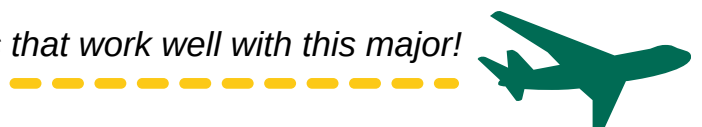
MAJOR COURSES ABROAD

Students majoring in Actuarial Science should prioritize taking major courses at Siena. With few exceptions (such as ECON 101 or 102), most of these courses cannot be done abroad.

Students can complete Core requirements abroad including, *but not limited to*: CDA (Creative Arts), CDS (Social Sciences), and Franciscan Core (CFD, CFH, CFJ, CFN).

Actuarial Science students who wish to go abroad for a full semester should plan to do so during the spring of junior year.
