MAJOR COURSES ABROAD

Students majoring in Astrophysics should prioritize taking major courses at Siena. While plenty of study abroad programs offer physics coursework, most of the major courses cannot be done abroad, with few exceptions.

Students can complete Core requirements abroad including, but not limited to:
