MAJOR COURSES ABROAD

Students majoring in Business Analytics should prioritize taking major courses at Siena, including their Business Core. With few exceptions (such as CSIS elective), most of these courses cannot be done abroad.

Students can complete Core requirements abroad including, *but not limited to*: CDA (Creative Arts), CDS (Social Sciences), and Franciscan Core (CFD, CFH, CFJ, CFN).
