Studying abroad enables communications students to think critically about the media through a global lens, meet with local and regional business leaders, pursue professionally-driven internships in their field, and so much more!

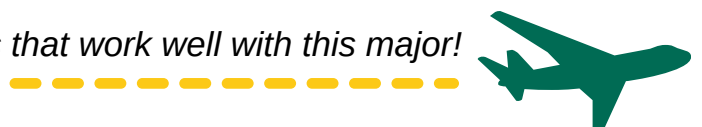
MAJOR COURSES ABROAD
