### **MAJOR COURSES ABROAD**

Students majoring in Communications should prioritize taking major courses at Siena. Elective courses and internships are available abroad in all four tracks: journalism, digital marketing, sports communications and political communications.

Students can complete Core requirements abroad including, but not limited to:

- Franciscan Core (CFD, CFH, CFJ, CFN)
