MAJOR COURSES ABROAD

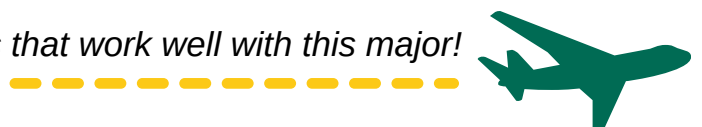
The following courses in the Creative Arts major can be completed abroad:
