## MAJOR COURSES ABROAD

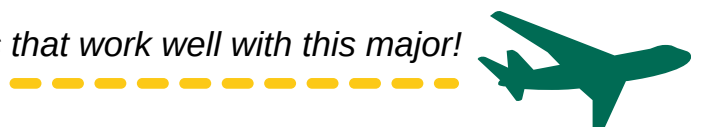
The following courses in the Criminal Justice Studies major can be completed abroad:
