MAJOR COURSES ABROAD

The following courses in the economics major (BA or BS) can be completed abroad:

ECON Electives

Students in the Economics BS major should prioritize taking Business Core at Siena. With few exceptions, most of these courses cannot be done abroad.

Students can also complete Core requirements abroad including, *but not limited to*: CDA (Creative Arts) and Franciscan Core (CFD, CFH, CFJ, CFN).

The following study abroad locations offer excellent courses for Economics students:

London School of Economics (London, England)

full-year program only

Queen's University (Belfast, Northern Ireland)

Coursework includes:

- Public Finance

University of Manchester (Manchester, England)

Coursework includes:

University of Cape Town (Cape Town, South Africa)

- Economic Challenges in Africa
