STUDYING ABROAD AS AN EDUCATION STUDENT

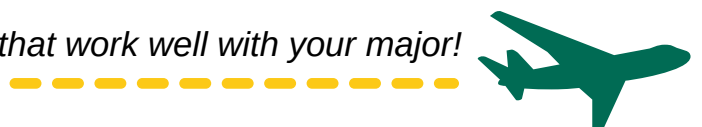
Study abroad enables education students to examine the educational systems and environments of another culture, gain practical teaching experience in foreign classrooms, learn how to connect with a diverse demographic of students, and so much more!

MAJOR COURSES ABROAD

Education students must take their EDUC coursework at Siena, however students can take foreign language or discipline credits abroad. In addition, since student teaching takes place during the senior year, students aiming for a semester abroad should be sure to plan ahead.

Students can complete Core requirements abroad including, *but not limited to*: CDA (Creative Arts), CDS (Social Sciences), and Franciscan Core (CFD, CFH, CFJ, CFN). Several study abroad programs also enable students to teach abroad for-credit or as a service learning opportunity.
