Korea University (Seoul, South Korea)

Coursework includes:

- History of Classical Korean Literature
- Modern Korean Fiction
- English Literature and the Enlightenment

University of Roehampton (London, England)

Coursework includes:

- Tragedy: Classical, Shakespearean, Cinematic
- Modern and Contemporary Dystopias
- Black British and American Writing
- Questioning the Canon

Kansai Gaidai University (Hirakata City, Japan)

Coursework includes:

- East Asian Literature and Culture in Translation
- Kodai to Gendai: Influences of Literature on Japanese Society and Culture
- Monsters, Ghosts and the Making of Modern Japan
