MAJOR COURSES ABROAD

Students should prioritize taking Business Core courses at Siena. With few exceptions, most of these courses cannot be done abroad.

Students can also complete Core requirements abroad including, but not limited to: CDA (Creative Arts), CDS (Social Sciences), and Franciscan Core (CFD, CFH, CFJ, CFN).
