STUDYING ABROAD AS A HEALTH STUDIES MAJOR

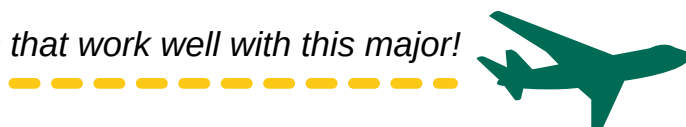
Study abroad enables health studies students to examine global trends in public health and policy, engage in healthcare systems in the developing and developed world, pursue professionally-driven internships, and so much more!

MAJOR COURSES ABROAD

Students majoring in Health Studies should prioritize taking major courses at Siena. With few exceptions, most of these courses cannot be done abroad. Students should therefore meet with their academic advisor and the Center for International Programs early in their Siena career to best plan out how study abroad fits into their curriculum. Students wishing to go abroad for a full semester should plan to do this during spring of junior year.

Students can complete Core requirements abroad including, *but not limited to*: CDA (Creative Arts), CDS (Social Sciences), CFD (Diversity) and CFH (Heritage).
