# **MAJOR COURSES ABROAD**

The following courses in the History major can be completed abroad:

- European History (HEUR) electives
- Non-Western History (HNW) electives
- American History (HAM) electives
- HIST electives
- Foreign Language credits

Students can also complete Core requirements abroad including, *but not limited to*: CDA (Creative Arts), CDS (Social Sciences), and Franciscan Core (CFD, CFH, CFJ, CFN).

### STUDY ABROAD LOCATIONS

The following study abroad locations offer excellent courses for History students:

#### Freie Universität (Berlin, Germany)

Coursework includes:

- Modern German History in European Context: A Thematic Approach
- Berlin: History, Memory, Literature
- Islam and Europe: Historical and Contemporary Dimensions

#### Universidad Veritas (San José, Costa Rica)

Coursework includes:

- Contemporary Latin American History
- Costa Rican Economic Development
- Human Development in Latin America

#### AMIDEAST (Amman, Jordan)

Coursework includes:

- The Arab Gulf and the Indian Ocean
- The History of Colonialism in the Middle East and North Africa

#### Kansai Gaidai University (Hirakata City, Japan)

Coursework includes:

- Japanese Cultural History: Ancient and Medieval
- 20th Century Asian History Through Film
- The History and Culture of Japanese Martial Arts

#### **Jagiellonian University (Krakow, Poland)**

Coursework includes:

- The Holocaust and its Cultural Meaning
- The Cold War
- History and Society of Food and Drink in Poland
- Poland and Europe in the 20th Century
