MAJOR COURSES ABROAD

The following courses in the Marketing major can be completed abroad:

- Select MRKT courses, including MRKT 327 or 334
- MRKT electives

Students should prioritize taking Business Core courses at Siena. With few exceptions, most of these courses cannot be done abroad.

Students can also complete Core requirements abroad including, *but not limited to*: CDA (Creative Arts), CDS (Social Sciences), and Franciscan Core (CFD, CFH, CFJ, CFN).
