MAJOR COURSES ABROAD

The following courses in the Mathematics major can be completed abroad:

• MATH electives (all levels)

Students should prioritize taking auxiliary courses (i.e. physics, computer science, chemistry) at Siena. Most of these courses cannot be done abroad.

Students can also complete Core requirements abroad including, *but not limited to*: CDA (Creative Arts), CDS (Social Sciences), and Franciscan Core (CFD, CFH, CFJ, CFN).
