Study abroad enables nursing students to examine global trends in healthcare systems and public health, gain valuable international perspectives for the future, engage in local communities across 55 countries, and so much more!

MAJOR COURSES ABROAD

Students majoring in Nursing should prioritize taking major courses at Siena. These courses cannot be done abroad. However, students can complete Core requirements abroad *including*, *but not limited to*: CDA (Creative Arts), CDR (Religion), and CFH (Heritage).

Due to the high demand of courses and clinical experience, Nursing students cannot go abroad for a full semester. Short-term programs are available (such as winter or summer) to take Core requirements or general electives, and some faculty-led travel courses (such as NURS 410 to Jamaica) are offered specifically for Nursing students.
