MAJOR COURSES ABROAD

Students majoring in Theater should prioritize taking major courses at Siena. Certain courses in each track - design, management, and performance - may be taken abroad, pending approval.

Students can also complete Core requirements abroad including, but not limited to:

- CDS (Social Sciences)
- Franciscan Core (CFD, CFH, CFJ, CFN)



STUDY ABROAD LOCATIONS

The following study abroad locations offer excellent courses for Theater students:

University of Roehampton (London, England)

Coursework includes:

- Shakespeare and Contemporary Performance
- Theater Criticism
- Introduction to the London Stage

Queen's University Belfast (Belfast, Northern Ireland)

Coursework includes:

- The Art of the Actor
- Drama and Mental Health
- Radio Drama

College Year in Athens (Athens, Greece)

Coursework includes:

- Performing (in) Athens: Exploring the City through Theatre and Performance
- Greek Theater: Ancient and Modern

University of Glasgow (Glasgow, Scotland)

Coursework includes:

- Live Art: Histories, Theories and Practices
- Performing Memory
- Practicing Location: Space, Place and Landscape
- The Activist Stage
- Women and Drama in the English Renaissance Period

Australian Catholic University (Melbourne, Australia)

Coursework includes:

- Australian Drama: History, Performance and Perspectives
- "That Is the Question": Shakespeare and Renaissance Theatre
- On Screen: Movies, TV, Video Games
