MAJOR COURSES ABROAD

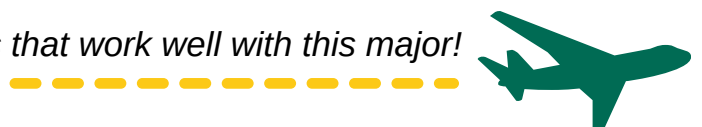
The following courses in the Visual Art & Design major can be completed abroad:
